

# Safety Instructions

When using electrical appliances, basic safety precautions should always be followed.

Check that the voltage indicated on the rating plate corresponds with that of the local network before connecting the appliance to the mains power supply. This appliance contains no user serviceable parts. If the power supply cord, plug or any part of the appliance is malfunctioning or if it has been dropped or damaged, do not use. Only a qualified electrician should carry out repairs. Improper repairs may place the user at risk of harm.

Do not remove the adaptor from the mains power supply by pulling the cord; switch off and remove the plug by hand.

Do not use the adaptor to recharge non-rechargeable batteries or any other appliance.

Do not use the appliance for anything other than its intended use.

Take care when equipping accessories with rotating parts as this could cause entrapment.

Switch off the appliance, disconnect it from the mains power supply and allow to cool fully before changing or fitting accessories

and before cleaning or user maintenance. Use of an extension cord with the appliance is not recommended.

Only use the appliance with the power supply unit provided.

This appliance should not be operated by means of an external timer or separate remote control system.

This appliance is intended for domestic use only. It should not be used for commercial purposes.

Caution: The extension tube contains electrical connections. Do not use to suck up water. Do not immerse in water for cleaning. The extension tube should be checked regularly and must not be used if damaged.

## **Battery Safety**

The supply terminals are not to be short-circuited.

In the event of a battery pack leaking, do not allow the liquid to come in contact with the skin or eyes. If contact has been made, wash the affected area with copious amounts of water and seek medical advice.

Secondary cells and batteries need to be charged before use. After extended periods of storage, it may be necessary to charge and discharge the battery pack several times to obtain maximum performance. Do not leave a battery pack on prolonged charge when not in use.

Do not use any charger other than that specifically provided for use with the product.

Do not use any cell or battery which is not designed for use with the product. Keep batteries out of the reach of children. Do not crush, puncture, dismantle or otherwise damage the battery pack. Do not store above 60 °C.

Avoid storage in direct sunlight.

Do not expose the battery pack to heat or fire as it may explode.

Do not subject the battery pack to mechanical shock

Make sure that the dust container and HEPA filter are cleaned regularly.

#### Don't

Use the vacuum cleaner without the HEPA filter or dust container in position.

Use the vacuum cleaner to pick up flammable liquid, matches, cigarette ends, hot ashes or any hot, burning or smoking objects.

Use the vacuum cleaner to pick up water or any other liquid, as this poses risk of an electric shock.

# Care and Waintenance

Wipe the external surface of the vacuum cleaner with a soft, damp cloth and allow to dry thoroughly.


Do not use any harsh or abrasive detergents or cleaning agents.

Do not immerse the vacuum cleaner in water or any other liquid.


- 1. REMOVE THE PET TOOL FROM THE EXTENSION TUBE OR SUCTION HOSE.
- 2. PUSH THE PET TOOL BRUSH BAR RELEASE TAB AND ROTATE THE PET TOOL BRUSH BAR IN AN ANTICLOCKWISE DIRECTION.



3. LIFT THE BRUSH BAR AND IMPELLER OUT OF THE PET TOOL. REMOVE ANY DEBRIS FROM THE BRUSH BAR.

4. ONCE CLEANED, REPLACE THE BRUSH BAR. THE SPINDLE END OF THE IMPELLER SHOULD BE ALIGNED WITH THE SLOT ON THE BRUSH BAR WITH THE TOOL IN AN UPRIGHT POSITION.

5. TWIST THE BRUSH BAR IN A CLOCKWISE DIRECTION UNTIL IT LOCKS INTO PLACE.



TAKE CARE WHEN CLEANING THE PET TOOL DUE TO THE NUMBER OF SMALL PARTS. CLEAN THE PET TOOL BRUSH BAR ON A REGULAR BASIS.


